Dear Mr. Lewis:

Thank you for taking the time to meet with me to explain the Bullet ID System.

I believe this to be a unique and potentially very useful tool for police agencies to consider when purchasing ammunition. From an investigative perspective, I see it as an invaluable forensic tool as it relates to firearms offences. Bar code scanning of bullets would also have merit in the inventory control and management application.

Greater Sudbury Police Service is part of the Police Purchasing Cooperative Group (PCPG) which is dedicated to providing participating police agencies with effective, efficient solutions that meet appropriate safe, operational, financial, environmental, legislated and technological needs. In fulfilling its mandate, the Group exchanges information, standardizes common specifications and develops cooperative agreements for procurement purposes.

Ammunition procurement is one such police commodity that is coordinated by the PCPG. In fact a working group for this purpose has recently been established which is tasked with examining ammunition standards and specifications. Your information may be of interest as part of their considered review.

Scott Lindsay from Peel Regional Police is currently the Chair of the PCPG and can be reached at 905.453.2121, extension 3010. Our CAO, Sharon Baiden has spoken to Scott and briefed him on the etching feature for consideration. She has advised that you may be reaching out to him given the context of our discussion. He can then connect you with the working group directly.

In my capacity as a current Executive Board Member on the OACP, I will also ensure police leaders are made aware of the innovation you have developed relative to the etching of bullets. I believe your solution may be of interest to not only police agencies but also other law enforcement bodies and various levels of government. Given that some US States are contemplating legislative guidance for this type of bullet marking, this may also be of interest to the Canadian government.
